### **Instructions for Viewing Multimedia Learning Resources**

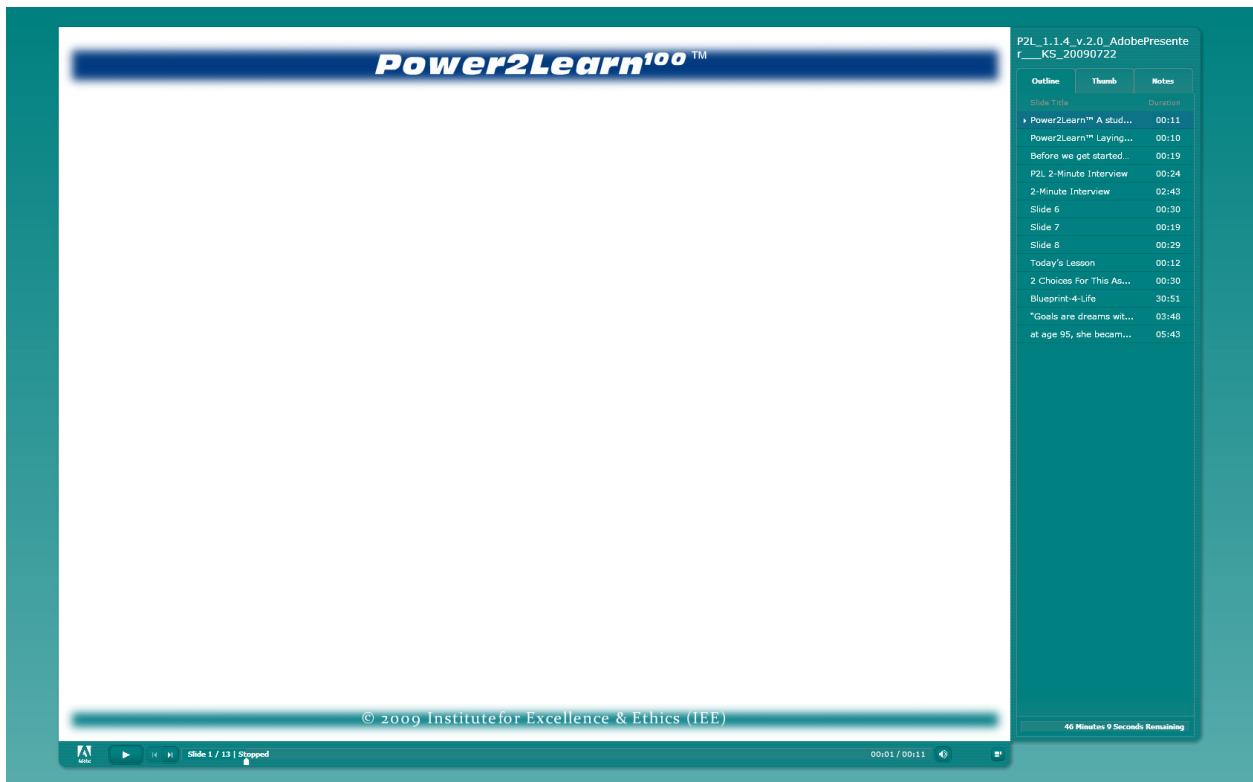
To view Multimedia Learning Resources for **Power2Learn™** and **Power2Teach™**, it is necessary to download and install free Adobe Reader 9.1 or higher by going to this url:

When you double-click a Multimedia Learning Resource pdf file, it will open and start playing automatically. Right-click on the presentation screen and select “Full Screen Multimedia” to get the full-screen view like that in the screen shot below. Note the Control Panel in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen that allows one to pause, resume play, advance forward or backward one slide, and adjust the volume of the presentation.



The bottom-right toggle button in the Control Panel changes the screen view from the one shown above to the one shown below (and back):



The latter view shows the duration of each slide and the present location at the bottom of the screen. It also provides additional navigation controls in the tabs on the right-hand side of the screen, allowing one to jump immediately to the needed slide or to see the Notes for each slide.

Please note that if there is another version (earlier than 9.0) of Adobe Acrobat Reader or Acrobat Professional installed as the default program, double-clicking the Multimedia Learning Resource file may not open it. Instead, one would need to right-click on the file name and choose “Open with Adobe Reader 9” option.
